Outgoing Ambassador of the Republic of Korea to the Republic of Namibia, H.E Dong Chan Kim paid this morning a farewell courtesy call on H.E, President Hage G. Geingob

Thanking President Geingob for Namibia's support for the denuclearization of the Korean Peninsula, Ambassador informed that relations between Namibia and South Korea continue to grow, including in the area of tourism.

The Ambassador also thanked President Geingob for providing leadership to SADC, and committed to request the Government of South Korea to reopen an Embassy in Namibia.
